If you don't agree with me, I will shout you down, get you fired, call you every name in the book, burn the book, then burn your business. It is a virus of stealing, burning, shooting, and beating.

Dear Lord, deliver us from both viruses on this Wednesday in June. Help us to love you and love our neighbors. We pray for a time when we as Christians can gather again in person. We pray and seek reformation where it is needed in our country not by cancelling and bullying and silencing but by working together. More than ever Lord we need your help.

In Philippians 1:3-11 Paul writes such heartfelt encouragement to the Christians in Philippi. They had sent Epaphroditus with gifts for Paul while he was in prison. Epaphroditus became ill while with Paul and almost died so Paul sent him back (2:25, 28). All of his emotion comes out in 3-11. In 1:8-9 Paul longs for the people of that church as Christ longs for us. And Paul hopes that their love may overflow so they can determine what is best.

We must not lose our love nor our insight and common sense.
